 - be a sustainable community with a healthy culture

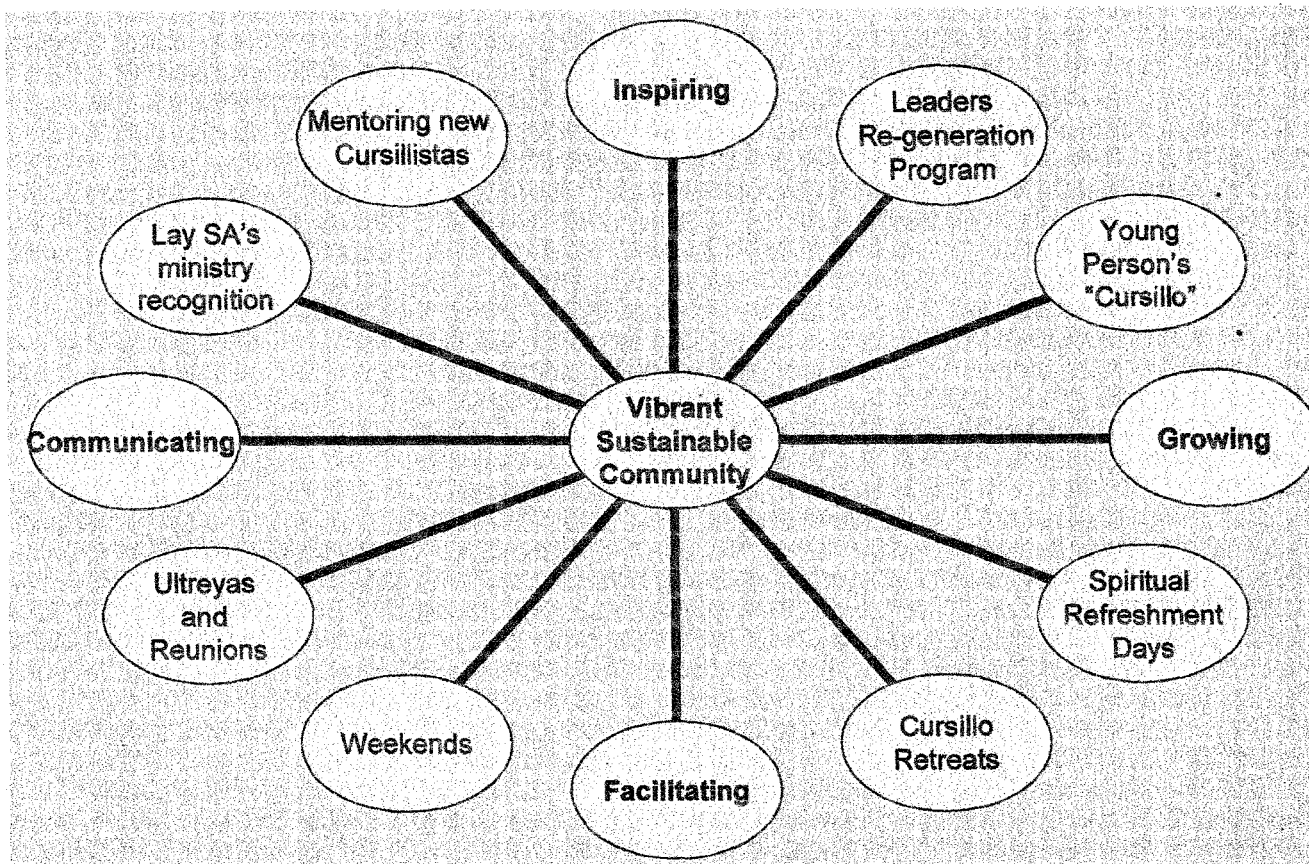
